

## DUC-owned properties in Quebec

It is the user's responsibility to ensure that they are accessing the property that is exclusively owned by DUC and that they comply with that municipality's firearms dump laws. Hunters are reminded that some of these properties have public trails and therefore must ensure the safety of all users. In addition, these properties are to be restored, managed, and maintained on a regular basis. At times, there may be contractors and DUC staff working on the property who could interfere the access to the property.
